About this Program:

Approximately 70 percent of all auto insurers in the U.S. use bodily injury assessment software to evaluate claim value in auto injury cases. Most of them conceal its use or allege that they no longer use the software. These programs require specific information to generate maximum claim value. This seminar will provide doctors with the information necessary to help their patients receive payment for the care they need. Some of the topics of discussion will include:

- * The scrutiny applied to bill and record review
