About this Program:

In this presentation, Dr. Lockenour will present topics to improve the ability to identify and treat common orthopedic disorders with nutritional interventions to improve patient responses and outcomes to care, based on current evidence. He will also provide up to date information to identify, manage, treat and monitor multiple Metabolic & Functional Disorders that result in poor treatment outcomes if not addressed.

Dr. Lockenour will discuss commonly encountered orthopedic conditions seen in chiropractic practice and discuss evidence-based nutritional protocols used in the management of orthopedic disorders. Attendees will be presented with techniques on how to apply nutritional intervention strategies to support the treatment and recovery of patients with common orthopedic conditions such as disorders of the Cervical Spine, Thoracic Spine and Ribs, Lumbar and Pelvis Spine, and Upper and Lower Extremities.

Also in this presentation, Dr. Lockenour will present common signs and symptoms, functional diagnostic testing, and ways to improve treatment outcomes for common Metabolic Disorders such as Adrenal Insufficiency, Hypoglycemia, Diabetes & Syndrome X, and Hypothyroid Disorders. He will discuss the mechanism of the disease process, how the body begins to malfunction, signs and symptoms of Functional Metabolic Disorders and the impact of Functional Metabolic Disorders with Chiropractic Care.

He will also discuss how to identify high-risk patients and situations that may lead to adverse outcomes or malpractice exposure. Participants will learn to recognize red flags, contraindications to care, and specific scenarios that require modification or referral. Attendees will leave with practical tools to improve patient safety, enhance documentation, and reduce liability in the day-to-day chiropractic practice.

What about John Lockenour?

John Lockenours, D.C., DABCO, DABCA is a 1977 graduate of Palmer College of Chiropractic. After completing his graduate degree, he completed two diplomats through the American Board of Chiropractic Orthopedist and the American Board of Chiropractic Acupuncture. Additional certification in chiropractic rehabilitation, manipulation under anesthesia, and applied diagnostic testing give him a vast background that he brings to teaching and practice. Dr. Lockenour built one of the largest and most successful chiropractic practices in the State of Indiana. As vice president of the Indiana State Chiropractic Association, he was the only doctor to receive chiropractor of the year on two occasions, once in 1991 and again in 2000. For the last 40 years, Dr. Lockenour has taught postgraduate courses in orthopedics, whiplash injuries, physical therapy, nutrition and acupuncture. He was a previous Assistant Professor at Palmer College of Chiropractic Florida and now maintains a practice in Port Orange, Florida. His informative and motivational style of speaking makes him a very popular speaker and sought-after practitioner.
