Dr. Benton is also the owner of Cypress Pointe Urgent Care in Hammond, Louisiana. Dr. Benton will discuss how to evaluate and detect emergency symptoms and types of treatment that he routinely provides in conjunction with chiropractic care.

Dr. Eric Oberlander is a neurosurgeon with the Neuromedical Center in Baton Rouge. He is also affiliated with Cypress Pointe Surgical Hospital in Hammond. He is also affiliated with LSU athletics as a team neurosurgeon. Dr. Oberlander is a premier and highly sought after neurologist treating patients throughout the State of Louisiana and across the nation. Dr. Oberlander will discuss treatment of neurologic injuries, referral of patients with such conditions and the collaborative approach for care. **Dr. Lance Wehrly** is an orthopedic physician specializing in joints and extremities. Dr. Wehrly has his own practice with Lakeview Physicians Group. Dr. Wehrly is also an orthopedic for Lakeview Hospital Emergency Department. Dr. Wehrly will discuss techniques to recognize orthopedic bone injuries which may require emergency or surgical intervention and other types of orthopedic conditions for which conservative care is more appropriate.

Dr. Chad Domangue is a neurologist and interventional pain management specialist. Dr. Domangue is an advocate for chiropractic care and recently appeared on television news educating the general public after a national news story adverse to a Georgia chiropractor occurred. Dr. Domangue will discuss common neurological and pain management issues that he faces and the collaborative approach he utilizes with chiropractic care for overall wellness of the patient. **Dr. Geralyn Datz** is President and Clinical Director of Southern Behavioral Medicine Associates. She is a licensed clinical psychologist who specializes in behavioral medicine. Dr. Datz is also a licensed Medical Psychologist in Louisiana. Dr. Datz will discuss mental health topics that all too often are left untreated. Dr. Datz will also discuss the types of trauma suffered by patients which create mental health injury; how chiropractors who have repeat interaction with patients can recognize such injuries and treatment options.

Mr. Carrick will discuss techniques including reconstructing accident scenes. His discussion will assist chiropractors in determining mechanism of injury when the facts are not abundantly clear.
