**Tim Richardson** is an attorney and holds a Masters of Business Administration. Mr. Richardson has been practicing law since 2001; practices across the state and serves as counsel for the Louisiana Sheriff's Association. Mr. Richardson keeps abreast of changes in the law; legal principals affecting chiropractors; and trends by insurers on chiropractic reimbursement. Mr. Richardson will discuss topics of ethics; legal updates; billing protocol and insurance vs. private/third party pay.

**Dr. Artemus Flagg** is a pain management specialist. Dr. Flagg served as a Battalion Flight Surgeon and Brigade Flight Surgeon during his combat tour in Iraq. Following his tour, he was promoted to the rank of Major and was appointed as the Chief Flight Surgeon and Chief of the Physical Exam Section at the DiLorenzo TRICARE Health Clinic at the Pentagon. He completed his residency in Anesthesiology and further enhanced his medical training with a Fellowship in Pain Medicine, both at John Hopkins University School of Medicine. He is a Pain Management Specialist at Bayou Pain & Spine. Dr. Flagg will discuss how in conjunction with chiropractic care, he seeks to provide the best patient care to reduce their pain and increase their functional activity level.

**Dr. Fernando Nussenbaum** is an orthopedic surgeon specializing in adult reconstructive orthopedic surgery and arthroplasty. Dr. Nussenbaum is with Paradigm Health Systems. Dr. Nussenbaum treats a wide range of orthopedic conditions, including knee and hip replacements, shoulder surgery, bursitis, arthritis, and the treatment of fractures and dislocations involving the lower arm, elbow, wrist, hip, and femur. He also has extensive experience in pediatric orthopedics, having spent five years at Texas Children's Hospital. Dr. Nussenbaum will discuss techniques to recognize orthopedic bone injuries which may require emergency or surgical intervention and other types of orthopedic conditions for which conservative care is more appropriate.

**Dr. Thomas Joel Berry** is a interventional pain management specialist with Paradigm Health System. After completing his residency in Anesthesiology at the University of Missouri-Kansas City, he was invited to join the prestigious Pain Management Fellowship Program at the University of Texas M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Houston. Is one of only 200 physicians in the United States to complete fellowship training in Interventional Pain Management at this world-renowned institution. Dr. Berry will discuss common neurological and pain management issues that he faces and the collaborative approach he utilizes with chiropractic care for overall wellness of the patient.

**Dr. Louis Passauer, Jr.** is the owner and operator of Passauer Family Dentistry in Mandeville, Louisiana. Dr. Passauer lectures nationally on topics including implantology, digital workflows, BCT, CEREC, restorative dentistry, InLab, and 3D printing. He is a Key Opinion Leader and Beta Tester for Dentsply Sirona and serves on the Visiting Faculty for CDOCS. Dr. Passauer will discuss dental health topics that all too often are left untreated.
